

Invitation to the Workshop "Inform-Prioritize-Collaborate: Cooperation of Regions on Innovation in Forest Management, Use of Wood and Forest-related Services" 29 January 2016 in Brussels

## (!New date after cancellation of the former date due to high security alert level in Brussels!)

Forestry and forest-based economy will play a major role in the EU bio-economy. The European Innovation Partnership Agricultural Productivity and Sustainability (EIP Agri) specifically addresses this issue and offers a framework for supporting innovation in forestry.

At the first Forest Innovation Workshop in May 2014, regional forest actors and experts joined forces for the identification of priority areas on which innovation support efforts through Rural Development policies and other European programmes should be focused. This initiative resulted in 4 main priorities for innovation in forestry:

- 1-Managing Impacts related to Climate Change
- 2-Supporting Wood and Biomass Mobilization
- 3-Supporting the Provision of Ecosystem Services
- 4-Improving Sustainable Forest Management Approaches and Tools.
